- Teacher appreciation lunch - May 5 lunch. 12:00 - 2:00 pm. Plan for 60-70.

- Dessert Theater has raffle items that need to be used for fundraising. Christina will ask ArtSpring organizers if we can hold a silent auction.

New Business

- Student Council

May 29th date is the date for prom. A request was made to share photo booth costs with the PA. \$775 was cost for last year for 3 hours. In addition, a request for the PA to provide a cake for students to be served at the end of prom. A motion was made from Frances Salles to approve \$400 for the prom photo booth with a Second from Tammy Orr. The motion carried with unanimous consent.

- Charter School Budget for Next Year

Christina Yamashiro presented the budget for the 2015-2016 school year. Revenue is projected to be \$2.1 million which is \$130k less than last year. Enrollment went down from prior year. Teacher salary levels jump \$10k per certification level. Annual rent is \$175k. Technology cart for classrooms has been purchased as part of technology plan. Teacher salary range is \$33k to \$59k. First day of school is tentatively set as August 10. 183 instructional days are budgeted, which is on the higher end compared to other Santa Fe Public Schools.

- Post School Career Preparation

Charles Hoy announced an May 19 session to share information with parent-student community about the college admissions and career preparation process. The event starts 7 pm at the school.

- SFAI Design Workshop

Keira Gonzales, educational specialist at Santa Fe Arts Institute, and Christina Gonzales, NMSA Visual Arts chair, announced a summer program at SFUAD and Santo Domingo Pueblo which includes college credits. SFAI Design Workshop - 6 week summer intensive for high school students. Introduction to architecture, social design. \$1,595 is the per student cost. 15 students selected into program.
