Each area is scored on a scale of 160 to 760 points.

The benchmark score in ERW is 430.

PSAT is a nationwide, multiple-choice test taken by about 3.4 million high school students every year–mostly sophomores and juniors. A great primer for the SAT® and even the ACT®, the PSAT includes math, critical reading and writing questions.

The percentage of 10th grade students who take the test is used by NMPED as one of the measures of college and career readiness. Therefore, all 10th graders take this test. NMPED covers testing fees 10th graders.

11th graders hoping to qualify as National Merit Scholarship Finalists also take the test. 11th graders who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch receive a fee waiver. Three NMSA students have been National Merit Scholarship Finalist, including one this year.
