FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES – MEAL CHARGING POLICY

New Mexico School for the Arts (the “School”), is a New Mexico public, statewide, residential, state chartered high school for students with exceptional promise in the arts.

The School is committed to providing a favorable environment for its students that is conducive to learning. In order to assure the students have access to good nutrition essential for learning.

Parents who do not qualify for subsidized meals are responsible for payment for meals. Meal charges are posted to the student’s PowerSchool account. Monthly lunch balance invoices will be sent electronically on or about the 15th day of each month.

Parents are responsible for meal charges up to 10 days from the time the application for a free or reduced-priced meal is received by the Food and Nutrition Services. A Free/Reduced Lunch application shall be posted on the School’s website and is available for pickup at the School at any time.

This Food and Nutrition Services – Meal Charging Policy was approved by the Governing Council of New Mexico School for the Arts, effective May 9, 2017
