Performance Pay

NMSA was not selected to receive the Pay for Performance funding.

Budgets

The final budget will be uploaded on or before June 30th. Additional expenditures will be reviewed during the Finance meeting

Parking Lot Repairs

The parking lot repairs are complete. However, NMSA no longer has access to the back exit creating a dangerous situation for students, staff and families.

A boiler issue has resurfaced and will need to be addressed in the fall.

Lease Extension

The lease extension has been signed.

Lease Purchase Agreement

We continue to work on the lease purchase agreements.

Clinical Counselor

NMSA has received a commitment of up to \$50,000.00 to cover the costs of a clinical counselor with the knowledge that NMSA will move the position into the operational budget within three years.

Delle Grant

The Delle Grant in the amount of \$75,000.00 has been received.
