The current focus is additional funding for Phase 2A-2 for 1.465M. This would include money for irrigation connections, security gates, decking, exterior metal trellis panels, the kitchen build-out, folding glass doors, the ceiling in the cafeteria and light fixtures.

XIV. Admissions Report Cindy Montoya

Cindy stated that applications for the 2021-2022 School Year are slightly lower than this time last year, but there is always an increase in activity as the deadline approaches. Talon Claybrook, one of our Visual Art Instructors, is on the Outreach Team and has been a huge asset. Currently 16 outreach classes are being offered.

XV. President's Report Cindy Montoya

Cindy began by congratulating Eric for his Excellence in Leadership Award for Charter Schools and recognized his compassion and passion and his commitment to NMSA. She remarked that he is exactly what we needed during COVID-19.

She also reported the following:

- NMSA collaborated with New Mexico School for the Deaf which has resulted in them using some of our online classes.
- Thirteen Visual Art students received Full Key Awards for their work in the 2021 Regionals. There were 76 submissions in total.
- Music Honors Ensemble went to Rio Manzanares and Jasper Miller.
- Dr. Dan Lopez is our Lobbyist for Capital Outlay Funds.

- The work session for NMSA Charter School Governing Board and NMSA Art Institute Board of Directors was postponed due to the Inauguration.
