**DISCIPLINE POLICY**

New Mexico School for the Arts (the "School"), a statewide public high school, provides access to a rigorous mastery arts and academic high school education for youth with passion and aptitude in the arts, leading to post-secondary learning, careers in the arts, and lives that contribute to society.


Disciplinary measures shall be aimed toward assisting each student in the development of self-control, social responsibility, and the acceptance of appropriate consequences for his or her actions. Administrators and designees shall refer to the Student and Family Handbook for procedural directives.

The School encourages parent/legal guardian involvement in matters of school discipline. Parents/legal guardians shall be informed of disciplinary measures taken to ensure parental understanding of school measures. The School shall maintain a record of disciplinary actions taken.

Corporal punishment is prohibited at New Mexico School for the Arts.

This Discipline Policy was adopted by the Governing Council of the New Mexico School for the Arts, effective July 11, 2014.
