TRANSGENDER BATHROOM POLICY

New Mexico School for the Arts (the "School"), is a New Mexico public, statewide, residential, state chartered high school for students with exceptional promise in the arts.

The School is committed to ensuring that all students shall be treated the same as all other students in the group of his or her affirmed gender in all respects of the education programs and activities offered.

Students shall have access to the restroom that corresponds to their gender identity at school. Where available, a single staff bathroom may be used by any student who desires increased privacy, regardless of the underlying reason. The use of such a single stall bathroom shall be a matter of choice for the student, and no student shall be compelled to use such bathroom.

This Transgender Bathroom Policy was approved by the Governing Council of New Mexico School for the Arts, effective June 13, 2017
